7. SDSA Report – Kelly Weaver – history has been compiled and submitted to SDSA. Convention is coming up and all are encouraged to book rooms very quickly as the hotel is booking up. Schedule is on the SDSA website and in the SnoPlainsman. Grant has been received for the 2020 Governor’s Ride. Some changes will be made to the SDSA by-laws and will be emailed to the club representatives and available to view in the SnoPlainsman.
